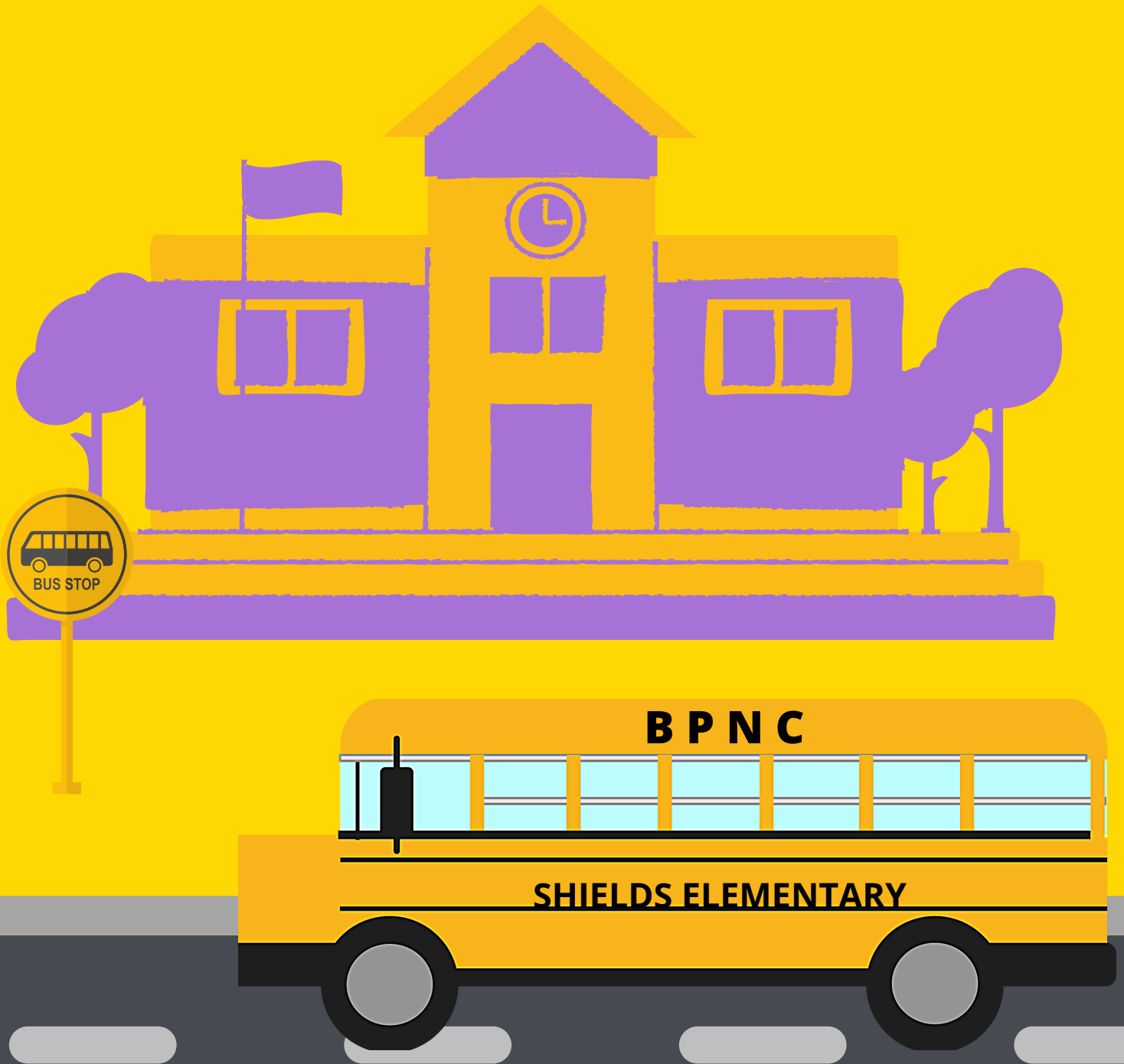


Shields Elementary After School Programming
